

Cockroaches in Your Home? Here's How You Can Help.

Cockroaches need food, water, warmth & shelter. They can enter through small cracks, gaps, plumbing openings, drains, or by being carried inside in boxes, bags & other items.

Before Your Technician Arrives:

- ☐ **Let us know where you have seen cockroaches or signs of activity.** This helps us identify areas needing attention.
- ☐ **Avoid using bug bombs, foggers, baits, or other pesticides.**
- ☐ **Remove items from affected areas**, including cabinets, closets, or any other areas of concern.
- ☐ **Clean** food crumbs, spills, grease & food residue from affected areas.
- ☐ **Store** food in sealed containers & **avoid** leaving pet food out unnecessarily.
- ☐ **Empty trash** regularly & keep areas around trash cans clean.

After Treatment:

- ☐ **Do not move or remove baits**, monitors or other treatment products unless instructed by your technician. This can interfere with treatment.
- ☐ **Continue keeping food & water sources unavailable.** Clean crumbs, spills & grease promptly.
- ☐ **Keep sinks & other wet areas as dry** as practical & **address plumbing leaks.**
- ☐ **Reduce hiding places** by keeping storage areas organized & minimizing unnecessary clutter.
- ☐ **Seal obvious cracks & gaps** around doors, windows, plumbing & other potential entry points.

What to Expect:

Cockroach control is often a process rather than an instant result. You may continue to see some activity while the population & hiding areas are being addressed.
