

Power Wash Your Home's Exterior

Dirt, algae, webs, egg sacs, & organic buildup can collect on porches, patios, siding, eaves, & other exterior surfaces. Periodic cleaning can help remove conditions that support pest activity & keep treated surfaces easier to maintain.

What You Can Do:

- ☐ **Power wash porches, patios, walkways, & other exterior areas** periodically during periods of heavy pest activity.
- ☐ **Remove** visible webs, egg sacs, algae, & organic buildup from exterior surfaces.
- ☐ **Pay special attention** to shaded or damp areas where moisture & buildup can accumulate.
- ☐ **Clean** around doors, windows, eaves, & other areas where pests commonly gather.
- ☐ **Keep outdoor furniture**, containers, & other items clean & free of accumulated debris.

Don't Overlook:

Moisture, algae, organic material, & accumulated debris can provide food or shelter for some pests & other insects. Keeping exterior surfaces clean can help reduce these conditions.

Periodic exterior cleaning can also help maintain professional treatments by removing buildup from treated surfaces.
