

What Are Stinging Insects?

Wasps, hornets, yellowjackets & other stinging insects may build nests around structures or forage around homes for food. Nests can be found around eaves, rooflines, trees, shrubs, garages, sheds, wall voids & other protected areas.

Before Your Technician Arrives:

- ☐ **Let us know where you are seeing stinging insects or where you suspect a nest is located.**
- ☐ **Keep children & pets away** from suspected nests.
- ☐ **Avoid approaching**, poking, spraying, or otherwise disturbing an active nest.
- ☐ **Cover** outdoor food, drinks & trash.

After Treatment:

- ☐ **Continue keeping children & pets away** from the treated area until your technician indicates it is safe.
- ☐ **Keep garbage containers closed** & clean up food or beverage spills outdoors.

What to Expect:

Activity may continue temporarily after treatment as individual insects return to the area or leave the nest.

Do not attempt to remove or treat an active nest yourself, particularly if it is difficult to access or located near an occupied area.
